Product data sheet

1. General description

Planar passivated very sensitive gate four quadrant triac in a SOT78 (TO-220AB) plastic package intended for use in general purpose bidirectional switching and phase control applications, where high sensitivity is required in all four quadrants. This very sensitive gate "series D" triac is intended to be interfaced directly to microcontrollers, logic integrated circuits and other low power gate trigger circuits.

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




Fig. 1. RMS on-state current as a function of mounting base temperature; maximum values

Fig. 2. RMS on-state current as a function of surge duration; maximum values




 α = conduction angle

Fig. 3. Total power dissipation as a function of RMS on-state current; maximum values

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




Fig. 6. Transient thermal impedance from junction to mounting base as a function of pulse width



Fig. 7. Normalized gate trigger current as a function of junction temperature




Fig. 8. Normalized latching current as a function of junction temperature





Fig. 9. Normalized holding current as a function of junction temperature

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




Fig. 11. Normalized gate trigger voltage as a function of junction temperature
